Kingfisher Mascot Task Force

WHEREAS, The Illinois Student Government is committed to advocacy on behalf of the student body; and,

WHEREAS, the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign has been - by inaction - noncommittal to the continued retirement of Chief Illiniwek in 2007; and,

WHEREAS, in 2019, Student Spencer Hulsey created and proposed a new mascot idea called "The Kingfisher", a native, predatory bird of Illinois naturally true to the orange and blue; and,

WHEREAS, the Senate strongly supported the Kingfisher referendum question with a vote of 41-0-1 and a referendum posed to the student body at-large passed on a vote of 4,222-3,597; and,

WHEREAS, upon the passing of the Kingfisher referendum, Chancellor Jones stated that the referendum was non-binding and there were no plans to implement a new mascot; and,

WHEREAS, negotiations with administration to further the adoption of the Kingfisher as a new mascot will take a concerted effort from the Illinois Student Government;

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Kingfisher Mascot Task Force is hereby established within the Senate; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Dana Yun be appointed as chair of this task force; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, membership on this task force will remain open to all members of the Third Assembly throughout the duration of this task force; and,

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Task Force shall be focus on the following:

- 1. Establishing and continuing ISG support for the Kingfisher
- 2. Creating plans to negotiate with administration and other University stakeholders on the adoption of the Kingfisher
- 3. Spreading awareness to students about the possibility of the Kingfisher as a mascot
- 4. Designing and working on the adaptation of the Kingfisher concept
